<b>ROTOR</b>	  	High		 4+	General Entry		Stand Upright Unaided												Riders stand inside a rotating drum and are subjected to intense spinning and centrifugal forces causing them to stick to the drum wall while the floor drops away.	
<b>CAROUSEL</b>	  	Low		 2	General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided on Horse												This is a rotating carousel ride. Riders may be seated astride the horses which move up and down throughout the ride cycle, or within a fixed Chariot.	
<b>FERRIS WHEEL</b>	  	Low			Ride Exit		Sit Upright												This is a rotating Ferris Wheel ride which takes riders to a height of approximately 40 metres in the air in a seated Gondola. It will stop periodically throughout the ride cycle	
<b>VOIARE!</b>	  	High		 4+	General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a high speed flying swing carousel with dramatic turning and spinning at height. Guests remain seated throughout the ride cycle.	
<b>TANGO TRAIN</b>	  	High		 2	Ride Exit		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a high speed circular motion thrill ride which travels forward and reverse. It subjects riders to dramatic acceleration, dipping and spinning forces while seated.	
<b>HAIR RAISER</b>	  	High			Ride Exit		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a high speed drop tower ride which is 35 metres tall. It drops at a speed of 80km/hour. Riders are seated and secured in a harness restraint.	
<b>BIG DIPPER</b>	  	High		 4+	General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided												This is an inline seated launch coaster which travels up to 72km/hour and loops 360 degrees multiple times throughout its course.	
<b>WILD MYUSE</b>	  	High		 4+	General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a high speed rollercoaster that includes sudden and dramatic acceleration, deceleration and bumping	
<b>DOUGEN CITY</b>	  	High		 2	General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a dodgem car style attraction which subjects riders to sudden and dramatic acceleration, deceleration, bumping and impact with other cars.	
<b>CONEY ISLAND GENERAL</b>	  	Low			Viewing Area														This is a traditional 1930's fun house attraction with Luna Park Sydney memorabilia, pin ball machines and general viewing area.	
<b>CONEY ISLAND SLIDES</b>	  	High		 4+	General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a slippery slide. Riders are seated on a mat with their legs in a pouch. Riders need to keep balanced and upright as they slide down.

		 Medium			General Entry		Stand Upright Unaided												This is a rotating barrel with two parts spinning in opposite directions. Riders need to keep balanced while walking through.	
		 Low			General Entry		Walk Unaided												This is a dark and disorientating maze of mirrors.	
		 Medium			General Entry		Stand Upright Unaided												This is a moving walkway.	
		 Medium			General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a spinning disc on which riders are seated and subsequently pushed off by centrifugal forces. Riders slide off the disc into bumper cushions.	
		 Medium			General Entry		Stand Upright Unaided												This is a moving walkway which goes up and down.	
		 Medium			General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a submarine shaped ride which flies into the air with flying magic carpet motion. Riders are seated whilst the sub swings high in a forward circular motion.	
		 High			General Entry		Sit Upright Unaided												This is a smooth riding rollercoaster which travels forward and backwards at a high speed of up to 76km/hour.

		 High					Sit Upright Unaided												This is an extreme thrill ride which rotates 360 degrees into the air while spinning around. There is a 240 degree option to ride. Riders are seated and secured in a harness restraint.
